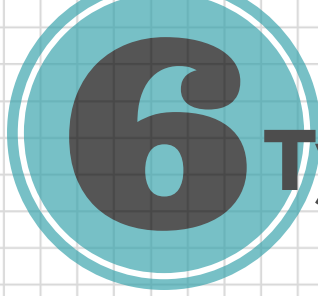


# Types of *gifted* learners QUIZ
